# WOMEN IN LEADERSHIP SHORT COURSE



## Ready to lead?

This course is for Australia Alumni and professional women to improve their leadership skills AND for men who are passionate about championing women's leadership in the workplace.

## Eligibility

Both female and male Australia Awards Scholarship alumni, as well as professional women from Government, Private Sector, and Civil Society Organisations, are encouraged to apply for this exciting opportunity.

Applicants must have professional English skills and be committed to attending and completing the course.

## Objective

Course participants will develop their leadership, influence, and communication skills as well as their confidence in their individual leadership abilities. You will strengthen your professional networks and develop a career plan to position you for future leadership opportunities.

## Training delivery

- The course will be delivered in-person in Dili during work hours over 8 days between 19 and 28 March 2024.
- There will be a pre-assessment for participants between 5 - 16 February 2024.
- The course will be highly participatory, combining leadership theory with experiential activities, self-reflection, and group projects based on a community development issue.
- The course will be delivered in English, but with the availability of simultaneous translation throughout.

## Training benefits

- Improve your leadership, influence and communication skills, and your confidence in your own leadership abilities.
- Improve your planning and management skills.
- Identify strategies to overcome some of the specific barriers faced by women aspiring to leadership positions.

## How to apply?

- Complete the application form and attach it to your email to TL3A. If you are currently employed, seek your supervisor's permission to attend the course, noting that it will require attendance during work hours over a two-week period.
